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## Post-Operative Instructions After Liposuction

So Take your medications as prescribed.

Drink plenty of fluids and try to maintain a high fiber diet.

Avoid strenuous activities until you have cleared it with your surgeon.

So Call your surgeon if you develop a fever higher than 101.5, chills, nausea and vomiting or dizziness.

So Call your physician if the site of your surgery becomes significantly red and/or swollen.

**Solution** Do not take any Aspirin or Motrin or medication containing aspirin or Motrin for 2 weeks after your surgery, unless instructed by your surgeon.

Ambulate several times a day to promote the circulation in your legs.

So If your calves become painful or you have significant swelling in your legs, please notify our office.

**Solution** Do not drive while taking narcotic pain medication or experiencing significant pain. When you drive you should be able to react to unforeseeable situations without hesitation.

So Call our office at 860-722-9544 to schedule your follow-up appointment.

So Keep the compression garment on as much as possible.

So You may take a shower 48 hours after your surgery. Reapply the compression garment after the shower.

You may see significant bruising and swelling in the area of surgery. This will subside over the first two weeks.
